

PASADENA BAR ASSOCIATION'S SCHOLARSHIP GUIDANCE NOTES

FOR THE MICHAEL HAY SCHOLARSHIP

Please ensure that you complete the application form and submit it by the deadline of June 1 to the mailing/email address shown below or to the Board of Directors of the Pasadena Bar Association directly or through any member of the Pasadena Bar Association. Applications received after that date will not be considered. The Board of Directors may select two recipients subject to ratification of the members attending the July meeting. An awards ceremony may be conducted in August. The awards will be tendered in two parts the first in August for one half of the award amount and the second half upon verification that the recipient is enrolled in the next semester. There are two scholarship awards 1st for a total of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and the 2nd for a total of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

The scholarship may be awarded considering the following guidelines except in extraordinary circumstances as determined by the Board of Directors and ratification by members attending the meeting considering ratification.

Please read these guidance notes carefully before deciding to make an application this year.

ELIGIBILITY

You may qualify for an award if you are a student enrolled in a law school and/or in a program associated with the legal field or the civil/criminal justice program of any local, state or federal jurisdiction; and

Be associated with a member of the Pasadena Bar Association or with the city of Pasadena, Texas or its immediate surrounding area. If you have a question as to if you are associated with member of the Pasadena Bar Association or the city of Pasadena please see below for a more detailed list to establish your association:

- a. Be a spouse, child or grandchild of a current member;
- b. Be a bona fide employee (full or part) of a current member;
- c. Be a spouse, child or grandchild of a former member;
- d. Be a bona fide employee (full or part) of a former member;
- e. Be a spouse, child or grandchild of a of an attorney practicing in Pasadena;
- f. Be a bona fide employee (full or part) of an attorney practicing in Pasadena;
- g. Be an applicant attending San Jacinto College Central Campus for an Associate's Degree;
- h. Be an applicant with an Associate's Degree from San Jacinto College Central Campus;
- i. Be an applicant residing in Pasadena;
- j. Be an applicant working (full or part time) in Pasadena; or
- k. You can show any other substantial connection to the Pasadena area.
